The company has undertaken a comprehensive approach, engaging its entire value chain, including clients and suppliers, in a collective effort to address climate change. Despite being a small emitter, Securitas recognizes the importance of taking full responsibility for its environmental impact.

Securitas commits to reduce absolute scope 1, 2, and 3 greenhouse gas emissions with by 42% by 2030 from a 2022 base year. This ambitious target aligns with the 1.5-degree goal set by the Paris Agreement and endorsed by the Science Based Target initiative.

"We are equally dedicated to ensuring the future sustainability of our planet.
